

#### **WHY IS CHURCH IMPORTANT?**

#### THE CHRISTIAN UNION IS NOT A CHURCH

- The Christian Union is a missional community that exists to give every student on campus the opportunity to hear and respond to the gospel of Jesus Christ. The CU cannot provide the pastoral care that you require for spiritual growth.
- The CU's beliefs are based upon the UCCF Doctrinal Basis and all teaching is focused on evangelism to non-Christians. We do not give teaching on all aspects of living a Christian life.
- Meeting with other Christians and being taught God's word is how we grow spiritually. We are best equipped for reaching non-Christians with the gospel when we are rooted in church community.
- Church community provides us with wisdom, guidance and accountability from older, more mature Christians, which the CU cannot offer as a body of students.
- The spiritual disciplines that comes with regular church attendance at university are a good indication of those you will keep in later life.

We believe that it is more important that you join a local church than the CU. We'd love you to be a part of both, but if you can only be a part of one, please choose church.

# QUESTIONS TO ASK YOURSELF WHEN TRYING OUT A CHURCH

- Is the church faithful to the gospel of Jesus Christ and does it teach the Bible? (Titus 1:9)
- Do the church leaders submit themselves to God's word? (Titus 1:7-9)
- Is there genuine concern among believers to spur one another on in their faith? (Hebrews 10:24-25)
- Is the church obviously a Christian community where people love one another? (1 John 3:11-18)
- Can I imagine feeling at home here and getting involved with the life of the church?
- Is it somewhere I could bring a friend?



#### STUDENTS MINISTRY


Encounter Church exists to help people to Encounter Jesus, to Raise Disciples, and to Release Missionaries.



#### A Final Note From Us

#### Before you arrive

#### When you arrive

- Be active in searching out churches as soon as you arrive make it a priority!
- Remember that no church is perfect, but consider whether you feel like you could enjoy growing and serving as a part of that church community
- Do your best to choose and settle as quickly as possible at a church, don't spend your whole time at university trying different churches!
- Get stuck in! All local churches will have different ways for you to get involved and serve, whether you are used to serving or not, have a chat with a church leader and see how you can get involved!
